

AMERICAN ART AWARDS Names The World's Best Contemporary Fine Artists

October 28, 2025. Los Angeles.

Artists from 63 countries competed in the 2025 AMERICAN ART AWARDS where 20 of the most revered galleries in the USA were sent online images to score in drawing, painting, sculpture, digital and photography. The 300+ winning works, 1st to 6th Place (and ties) in all 50 categories, will be featured in an upcoming movie and 75 articles.

"American Art Awards levels the playing field, so all artists have an equal opportunity," explains Thom Bierdz, president of American Art Awards, World Art Awards, Art Collectors Choice Awards. "This is why we only send the voting galleries the artwork images, titles, sizes and mediums used. No photos of the artists or bios are allowed. It's all about initial impact. However, if a gallery is so enamored with a piece, they are free to click on the artist's web site link and contact them for representation."

Kazakhstan, Kenya, Korea (Republic, South), Latvia, Lebanon, Lithuania, Malaysia, Mexico, Mongolia, Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Macedonia, Norway, Pakistan, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Russia, Slovakia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Thailand, Trinidad, Turkey, Uganda, Ukraine, United Kingdom, USA and Vietnam.

This year's six cash prizes go to fine artists in Spain, Japan, Uganda, Lithuania, New Zealand and USA, winning in oil, acrylic, graphite, color pencil and digital.

Winners of the 6 cash prizes are:

MOST WINS – CASH PRIZE goes to RAMÓN RIVAS of SPAIN. Rivas had 13 wins for his complex mostly digital works using his trademark Mixed Media-Rivismo on canvas.

MASTERPIECE – CASH PRIZE goes to TERESA BOLEN of JAPAN for her 18" realistic oil. "The Treasures Of Gansenji," combining floral, human figure and pagoda, won in 7 categories.

BEST OF SHOW – CASH PRIZE goes to SSEKIDDE MARTIN of UGANDA for the hyperrealistic color pencil portrait, "Baana Ba Kintu/Sons Of Kintu."

2ND HIGHEST SCORE IN ENTIRE CONTEST – CASH PRIZE goes to AIRIDA MILASAUSKIENE of LITHUANIA for her large realistic oil of an open-mouthed lion, "The King."

3RD HIGHEST SCORE IN ENTIRE CONTEST – CASH PRIZE goes to DAVID PATCH of NEW ZEALAND for his landscape graphite, "Exeter From Waterloo."

4TH HIGHEST SCORE IN ENTIRE CONTEST – CASH PRIZE goes to CHLOE LEE of USA for "Prey Within." The 20" acrylic captures the shock of a fish in another fish's mouth.
